

If you wish to leave a legacy to OVAID our details, which your legal advisor will need are simply:

You may leave a specific sum (a pecuniary gift) or or you can leave a share of what's left over after all your wishes have been carried out, which is a residuary gift. Many people choose this latter option because the value of the gift won't go down over time. Most of the gifts we receive are designed for general purpose which helps us as we can direct the funds to our most urgently needed projects but you might want your gift to fund a specific project or purpose, this is your choice. Whichever you choose, and no matter whether your gift is small or large, rest assured that we will use your legacy wisely and for maximum purpose.

Leaving a gift to an officially registered charity like Orangutan Veterinary Aid can also have tax advantages for you so you should speak to your professional advisor.

Making a will these days is much simpler than it used to be and, for simple wills there are purchasable templates e.g from retailers like W.H.Smith or on-line will makers. You must ensure that your final will document is legal though, and if you have any doubts you should seek legal advice. Make sure that the original will is signed by two independent people who are not beneficiaries. Your will should be kept in a safe place (e.g in your bank or with your solicitor) and it may be advisable to have two copies - one for yourself and one for your executors. Wills are a 'moving document' so make sure that you regularly review your will to ensure that it accurately reflects your wishes and takes account of any recent changes in your life. You can make a simple amendment such as adding a legacy gift to your will by adding a codicil - you do not necessarily need to rewrite your will.
